Ice Show: Discussed the theme that coaches came up with, per up above.

Grant and Scholarship Committee: Tara needs determination letter and is getting the affirmation letter. The sound system that we would like to purchase will be gotten next year.

New Items: Canada has opened up a new skating club. They are cheaper but for less time skating. Canada is also selling sheets.

Darlyss would like to start a Hockey Learn to Skate program. It will cap off at skill level for hockey. The dates would be from MEA weekend to January 15th. They would have no concessions and no fundraising to do. They would skate one time a week, maybe more if we can get it scheduled in there. We discussed the cost to be \$100. We would just be teaching them the skills of how to skate in hockey. No sticks and no pucks. If we don't get a minimum amount of people we won't be offering it. We could put Snowplow Sam on one half and the hockey kids on the other. Tara approved this and Stacy seconded it.

We also discussed since we are not lowering the first time skater's price, that we could give the family 2 free weekend passes for the Ice Show. The budget committee will determine this.
